## Bicycles/rollerblades/skateboards Policy

This policy is in place for your own safety as well as all members of the department. Please read and follow accordingly.

### **Bicycles**

Please note that bicycles may not enter or be stored inside the CHBE building (office, lab, project or club rooms included). The campus offers multiple options for storage, depending on the level of security you are looking for your bike:

**bicycle racks** are located next the East Mall and the Health Sciences Mall entrances; in addition, covered bicycle racks are located at the South entrance (more secluded from the street too!). Do not secure your bike to the benches, trees or anything else that is not a bike rack. Your bike will be removed and impounded. **secured bicycle storage** is available in the **Health Sciences** and **Thunderbird parkades**. It is **FREE** and right across the street; all you have to do is sign up to the trek program.: <http://trek.ubc.ca/transportation-options/cycling/cycling-facilities/>

you can **rent bicycle lockers** at two separate locations. These are a little further off from our building, but offer top security. Rates are reasonable, although it's not free.

It is important for us to keep our building safe and clean, so please follow this policy by choosing one of the options listed above if you are bringing your bike to school. The CHBE administration does reserve the right to remove or lock down any bicycles found inside.

Same as bicycles, rollerblades and/or skateboards may not be ridden inside the building. Please carry your skateboard until you are outside.


